Christmas in Genesis 2015-12-20

<u>2 Cor 1:16-22</u>

JC brackets all of time. <u>Gen 1:1, 26, Jn 1:1-3, Rev 22:21, Jn 5:39, Heb 1:1-2,</u> Col 1:15-17

- If JC in Gen just person of Trinity then He is impersonal, distant Creator & types/shadows still hidden from our understanding. <u>Gen 2:9</u>, <u>Rom 5:14, Gen 3:21, 4:4, Gen 14:18, Heb 7:3, Gen 22:8</u>
- But Christmas is in Gen: promise of coming Savior. <u>Gen 3:15, 12:1-3,</u> <u>13:16, 15:4-5, 17:7 & 19, 21:12, 22:18, 26:3-4, 28:14, 49:10</u>

Covenant **promises sure** because of **God's** unchanging **truthfulness** & **confirmed** by **Incarnation**.

- Probably not imagine male descendant, special "seed" who defeats serpent & brings blessing to all nations, be God Himself dwelling w/us.
 - If JC only a man, then Cxnty only human religion w/sinful, human savior. No savior at all. <u>Mt 1:23, Col 2:9, Heb 1:3a & 4:15,</u> <u>1 Jn 3:5, 2 Cor 5:21</u>

Because JC (Immanuel) sinless, died & rose so all promises of God true for us

- promises: grace, mercy, forgiveness, pardon, justification, sanctification, guidance, peace, joy, hope. Heb 4:16, 13:5-6, Ps 68:5, Phil 4:19, Rom 10:9-10, 1 Cor 10:13
 - His truthfulness lost if promises not kept! Not possible.
- **Promise world** of **no sin**, sorrow, or **death**...but it is **not this world**.
 - Never promised: no difficult/bad things, heal every illness, reverse consequences of sin/unwise decisions.
- Have faith in God's ability & desire to fulfill all His promises to you.
 - He is who He says & will do what He says. Josh 23:14, Is 26:3-4
 - Believing God to fulfill promises when not materializing demonstrates faith & glorifies God. 2 Cor 5:7, Heb 11:1

All promises God made to Abraham & his seed (Cxns) are certain because fulfilled & secured in JC. <u>Rom 15:8, Jn 3:17, 2 Cor 1:20-21, Col 1:19-20</u>

- "Yes" Greek= certain/true, "Amen" Hebrew=already accomplished.
 God not for us today & against us tomorrow because promises
 - based on God's mercy not our 'worthiness'
- God always for because JC received God's wrath for Cxns @ cross. Greatest, most wonderful promise of all is JC Himself, not His gifts.
 - Heart of Abrahamic covenant promise: God will be our God. <u>Gen 17:8</u>, <u>Jer 32:38–41, 2 Pet 3:8-9, Gal 3:29, Rom 8:31-32</u>
 - Love moved God to give/fulfill this spectacular promise to you.
 Present Gospel

Purpose of Christmas, of Christ's coming, is to confirm God's truthfulness & glorify God who is end of future & beginning of past:

- JC stands at end of every path upon which every human being who ever lived travels.
 - He is **Immanuel**, our **promise keeping God** who is **with us**.

2 Cor 1:16-22

I wanted to visit you on my way to Macedonia, and to come back to you from Macedonia and have you send me on my way to Judea. 17 Was I vacillating when I wanted to do this? Do I make my plans according to the flesh, ready to say "Yes, yes" and "No, no" at the same time?

18 As surely as God is faithful, our word to you has not been Yes and No. 19 For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, whom we proclaimed among you, Silvanus and Timothy and I, was not Yes and No, but in him it is always Yes.

20 For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory.

21 And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, 22 and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.
