PRAYER GUIDE: PSALM 63 (ESV)

A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah.

- ¹ O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water. ² So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.
- ³ Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.
- ⁴ So I will bless you as long as I live; in your name I will lift up my hands.
- ⁵ My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips,
- ⁶ when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night;

- ⁷ for you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy.
- ⁸ My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.
- ⁹ But those who seek to destroy my life shall go down into the depths of the earth;
- ¹⁰ they shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals.
- ¹¹ But the king shall rejoice in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.

- You are our strength and defense when the enemy attacks us v. 8, 9
- You protect Your people v. 9
- You delight in truth and justice v. 11
