Psalm 9 (ESV)

To the choirmaster: according to Muth-labben. A Psalm of David.

I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds.

² I will be glad and exult in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.

³When my enemies turn back,

they stumble and perish before [c] your presence.

⁴ For you have maintained my just cause; you have sat on the throne, giving righteous judgment.

⁵ You have rebuked the nations; you have made the wicked perish;

you have blotted out their name forever and ever.

⁶ The enemy came to an end in everlasting ruins; their cities you rooted out;

the very memory of them has perished.

⁷ But the Lord sits enthroned forever; he has established his throne for justice,

⁸ and he judges the world with righteousness; he judges the peoples with uprightness.

⁹ The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.

¹⁰ And those who know your name put their trust in you,

for you, O Lord, have not forsaken those who seek you.

 He is worthy of wholehearted thanksgiving v. 1
- He has done wonderful deeds vv. 1,11
- His name is worthy of glad exultation and songs of praise – vv. 2,11
- He is God Most High v. 2
- He confounds our enemies before His presence v. 3
- He executes righteous judgement vv. 4, 7-8
- He rebukes and brings an end to the wicked- vv. 5-6, 15-17 & 19-20
- He is our stronghold in times of trouble v. 9

¹¹ Sing praises to the Lord, who sits enthroned in Zion!

Tell among the peoples his deeds!

¹² For he who avenges blood is mindful of them; he does not forget the cry of the afflicted.

Be gracious to me, O Lord!
 See my affliction from those who hate me,
 O you who lift me up from the gates of death,

that I may recount all your praises, that in the gates of the daughter of Zion I may rejoice in your salvation.
