PRAYER GUIDE WEEK OF OCTOBER 24 – 30

Ephesians 2:11-22

¹¹ Therefore remember that at one time You Gentiles in the flesh, called "the uncircumcision" by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands— ¹² remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. ¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. ¹⁴ For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility ¹⁵ by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, ¹⁶ and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. ¹⁷ And he came and preached peace to You who were far off and peace to those who were near. ¹⁸ For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹ So then You are no longer strangers and aliens, but You are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him You also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

REVERENCE - God's Praiseworthy Attributes:

- He transforms our identity (vv. 11-12)
- He gives us real hope (v.12)
- Christ's sacrifice/shed blood brings real reconciliation (v. 13)
- Christ brings real peace and abolishes division (v. 14)
- Christ creates "oneness" out of human differences and division (v. 15)
- Christ reconciles relationships and destroys hostility (v. 16)
- Christ produces lasting peace between us as we draw near to him (v. 17)
- He gives all believers access to the abundance of His Spirit (v. 18)
- He transforms our enmity to make us "fellow citizens, saints and members" of His family (v. 19)
- He gives us a solid foundation of truth for our thoughts and lives, with Jesus as our Cornerstone (v. 20)
- He unites and builds us so that we might reflect His holiness in this world (v. 21)
- He is our source of growth so that the presence of the Spirit will be evident in and through His church (v. 22)
