Romans 8:29-30

For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. ³⁰ And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

Love our children before ever see them....could say we foreloved them. Before time, God chose/loved His children. <u>Revelation 13:8, 17:8, Romans 8:28-29a,</u>

 Because God chose to forelove you, He predestined you be glorified with Him forever.

Not: God sees who will decide for Him and puts them on His list.

- Still wouldn't give totally free choice because future is fixed.
- if true....God sees none choose Him; ALL are depraved, unable/unwilling to seek God unless God draws them to Jesus. *Romans 3:11, Jonn 6:44, 1 John 4:19*Sinners choose Jesus because God first chose and called them, then moved them to choose Jesus by renewing their hearts..... God is sovereign and the initiator.....we respond.
 - without sovereignty, all events would not work for your ultimate good and His ultimate purpose.
 - all human acts free in sense of immediate self-determination but also outworking of God's eternal purpose and foreordination.

Not merely aware/acquaint with person but implies intimate personal relationship based on God's sovereign choice before creation. <u>Romans 8:29a, Amos 3:2, Matthew 7:23, John 10:14-15</u>

- <u>not foresaw</u> future facts (who faith/saved) but "<u>whom</u> foreknew."
- o "whom He foreknew' equivalent to "whom He foreloved." before Foundation of the world God chose to 4love so He also predestined *Romans* 8:29, *Ephesians* 1:5, 11, 2:10
 - 4know = His choice love relationship with you. Predestined = prearranged plan to conform His foreloved to Jesus' image that ends in glory forever.
 - God made redemption plan in eternity past and carried it out perfectly in time

In time, God calls those He chose, justifies those He calls. *Romans 8:30, 2 Corinthians* 3:18, 2 Timothy 1:9,

- Not merely invite; effectual call creates what it commands: God's gift of faith.
 - o in Epistles when called... always results in salvation
- Justified = God's declaration we are righteous. Glorified is justified promised "good" reward.
- glorified = Jesus Christ returns, Christians live/dead instant, permanent, complete conform to Jesus Christ (not "gods"), free from all sin, receive glorified body, eternally glorified with Jesus Christ/"first-born"

- o "glorified" past tense to show good as done
- God's <u>ultimate</u> purpose not our "good" (does accomplish) but His glory.
- Jesus is glorified by glorifying us. <u>2 Thessalonians 1:10, 2:14.</u>
 Because God chose to forelove you, He predestined you to be glorified with Him forever.
- God irresistibly called > justified by Jesus imputed right> will glorify forever. Sovereign God CAUSE all work for you make it to eternal glory. <u>Romans 8:28, Psalm 103:2, Matthew 6:31-34</u>
 - Hope not fear in midst of world/personal instability.
 - more trust/faith in God, less worry.
 - Patience in adversity, part of His wise plan and ultimately for our good.
- Contentment: Lord watches/cares/give what need, exactly when needed. From first thought before foundation of the world to choose you > the day you are in His presence, salvation work *totally* of God...sustained and secure in His sovereignty providential control over our lives.
 - Our salvation is sure/certain hope because God originated it, effected it, will complete it.
