Give ear to my words, O Lord;

³ O Lord, in the morning you hear my voice; in the morning I prepare a sacrifice for you[[]a] and watch.

⁴ For you are not a God who delights in wickedness;

evil may not dwell with you.

⁵ The boastful shall not stand before your eyes; you hate all evildoers.

⁶ You destroy those who speak lies; the Lord abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.
