## Colossians: In Christ Alone 2024-01-21

## Colossians 1:26-27

the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints.

27 To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

**Key to determine truth** of any **religion or "theology**": **Who** they say **JC is.** Kabala

- Colossian heresy, 1860s Kenosis theory, 1990s open theism, today evangelical deconstructionism all diminish Jesus' nature. There is no Gospel or salvation without Biblical Jesus Christ!
  - Jesus alone is completely sufficient for salvation and sanctification.

Paul **61-63** A.D during **first imprisonment** in Rome, **same time** as he **wrote Ephesians**.

- Colosse small city 100 miles east of Ephesus in Asia Minor (today Turkey)
  Colossians teach Biblical view of Jesus Christ, antidote for heresy & foundation for Christian life. See outline at end.
  - Chapter 2 warning against doctrinal error called <u>"Colossian heresy"</u>
     Colossians 2:8-23
  - Asceticism is a higher spiritual state by abasement of body.
    - o common in **Hinduism**, Buddhism, **Judaism**, Islam.
  - Angel worship. Unworthy to approach Jesus Christ directly...go through angels.
    - o **Today**...through **saints**, **virgin Mary**. <u>1 Timothy 2:5</u>
  - True salvation through secret knowledge gained by human philosophy or rituals.
    - Gnostics: Jesus just man and Christ was divine Spirit came at Jesus' baptism and left at cross. Christ did not die, but simply Jesus died.

Who Jesus Christ is determined by scripture not human philosophy and ideas. <u>Colossians 1:15-20, 2:9</u>

- Jesus was, is and always will be fully God! The nature of Jesus Christ is nonnegotiable.
  - Firstborn: not what Jehovah Witness say, that Jesus first created (then not God/truly eternal).
    - Old Testament firstborn son language...heir, first in line as owner/master.

Firstborn implies Jesus' supremacy OVER all things...like creation and church.

- Jesus created, holds together, and rules over entire universe. SUN DOG.
  - Jesus holds together orbiting electrons, so atoms won't fly apart.

- "Firstborn from dead" proclaims Jesus Christ Lord of new body church.
  - First to rise to unending life (others before raised from dead to temporal life), means chief and leader of all with eternal life in heaven.

Paul reveals a mystery in response Gnostic search for "secret, hidden truths".

- Not that they can't understand but was hidden for ages & now revealed. Colossians 1:26-27, 2:2-4
  - Mystery equals Jesus Christ living IN you (gentiles), the hope of glory.

**United** with Jesus **profound** practical **implications**. <u>Colossians 2:6, 3:2-3, 5, 9b-10, 2 Corinthians 5:17</u>

- Christians died with Jesus therefore able to die to sin and put off old self.
- Raised with Jesus so can live like Jesus...holy and put on new self. Our supreme, omnipotent God dwells within Christians... Think about that.
  - Jesus Christ desires to impact all areas of your life: thoughts, words, actions, relationship.
    - He empowers you to put off old, put on new (sanctify), hold fast to Him, know Word, set minds on things above, live like Jesus Christ (holy) in community of believers. <u>Colossians 2:19, 3:16-17, 1:10, 28, 3:12a</u>
      - Same as keys to experience true, abundant joy in Philippians

Colossians teaches us: Jesus Christ alone completely sufficient for salvation & sanctification.

- Be on guard for any deviation that diminishes centrality of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
  - Gospel not first a theology or way of thinking but relationship with Jesus.
- Jesus Christ died for us so He might live in us and fellowship with us.
  - Delight in the fact you are passionately loved by indwelling Creator, Savior, Friend.
