1 Thessalonians: Contagious Christianity 2024-01-28

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

24 He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.

Coach Paul addressing **team** on **winning streak**. **Keep doing** what you're doing!

• **Contagious** Christianity is **attractive TO** world yet **distinct FROM** it. Thessaloniki **capital & largest city** in **Roman province** of **Macedonia**, with a population of 200,000.

• Still thriving Greek city of Thessalo-niki—also called Salonika (Salon-ik-a).

Paul founded church during 3-month stay on second mission journey. Acts 17:1-10

- Forced flee to Berea, then Athens, then to Corinth, where he wrote few months after leaving.
 - **Possibly Paul's first New Testament epistle** around 50-51 AD. **Others** believe **Galatians is the first.**
 - Sent Timothy to largely Gentile church of Greeks and women to encourage and ground new Christians in faith. 1 Thessalonians 3:1-2, 5 See outline and the end

Timothy returns with **good** report: **holding fast** to faith, **example** to others. <u>1</u> <u>Thessalonians 1:6-8, 4:1</u>

- Yet young church needed further instruction and exhortation so 1 Thessalonians call to action in time between conversion and death/home going.
 - Paul calls Christians to love & holiness in light of Jesus Christ Second Coming.

Contagious Christianity is attractive TO world when Christians love and strong work ethic.

- Thought Jesus coming soon so some stopped work and wait for Jesus come and take them away... Degenerated into freeloading. <u>1 Thessalonians</u> <u>4:11-12, 2 Thessalonians 3:11-12</u>
 - Work is a way God provides our own and others legitimate needs.
 - Legitimate needs: is issue "not a living wage" or way of living?
 - Sometimes need hand up from fellow Christians, but goal of lives not to live off others but be responsible and faithful. 2:9, Colossians 3:23, 4:5-6
 - As long as mentally and physically able, work with excellence in reliance on Lord's power for His glory.

• Strong connection between way Christians work and the attitude of unbelievers toward gospel.

Contagious Christians spread Gospel influence not only through strong work ethic but also by being attractive to world through loving one another. <u>1</u> <u>Thessalonians 4:9-10, 5:11-15</u>

What world first notices about Christians is how treat one another.
O Loving one another critical for attractiveness of Gospel

Contagious Christianity is attractive TO world yet distinct FROM it.

- Holiness is the distinctive that separates Christians in and from the world. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:3, 7, 2 Timothy 1:9a, Ephesians 1:4, 1 Peter</u> <u>1:15-16</u>
 - **One** of **God's purposes** in **calling** you was to **make you holy**.
 - God uses the time between conversion and death/home going to transform, restore, grow, mature....sanctify!
- Your sanctification as sure as your election, cause founded in God's faithfulness.
 - If He call you then He WILL sanctify you. <u>1 Thessalonians 5:23-24</u>
 - Blameless without fault, condemnation, guilt because of Jesus Christ. God does all!

Coach Paul addressing **team** on **winning streak**. **Keep doing** what you're doing!

- Be attractive TO world yet distinct FROM it.
 - Work hard, love one another, pursue holy living by power of the Holy Spirit....Lord is faithful, He will do it!
- Live joyfully and gratefully in promises of Gospel and hope of coming day of deliverance when Jesus returns and all wickedness end. <u>1</u> <u>Thessalonians 5:16-22</u>
