2 Timothy: The Bible, Your Anchor and Weapon 2024-02-18

2 Timothy 4:6-8

For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come.

7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

8 Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

What criterion use as measurement of success of our lives? Good works, money, family.

- Criterion Paul used: had he kept the faith in Jesus and fought good fight.
 - Bible was his and our anchor for keeping faith and weapon for the fight.

Nero started fire that destroyed half of Rome in 64 AD then blamed it on Christians.

 Christians now official enemies of state, subject public torture, and execution.

Paul charged with "propagating forbidden cult" and imprisoned second time after being free for several years after first imprisonment.

- Second imprisonment very different from first: in own rented house and cell, accessible and alone, hope for freedom, expected to die.....executed soon after writing 2 Timothy around 64-67 AD
 - Last will and testament: farewell and exhortation to friend. <u>See</u> outline at the end.

Church **constantly** under **hardship** and attacks, both **inside** and **outside** the church.

- Paul exhortation: stand firm, endure and be strong by being rooted in Scripture.
 - At end: asked for cloak warm body, Scripture to warm soul.
 - In dark and difficult time Jesus' love and faithfulness most tangible and real.
- Old Testament scripture Paul's foundation and anchor for keep faith. 2 Timothy 3:14-16a, 4:13

Both Old Testament and New Testament are "breathed out by God" ... Bible literally WORDS OF GOD.

- God's inspired rev of Himself written by authors guided by His Spirit
 - Thus infallible in original writings: incapable of error, never wrong, absolutely trustworthy. <u>2 Peter 1:19-21, John 17:17</u>
- No other authority needed, and no need for addendums!

- Bible reveals truth about sin and self, gospel, riches in Jesus, what happened in eternity past, and will happen in eternity future...
 - Gives wisdom that leads to salvation and ways to know and enjoy Jesus.
 - Equips for "every good work." 2 Timothy 3:16-17
- Scripture purpose: teach, challenge, correct, train, equip to fight good fight.
 - Fighting good fight same as keeping the faith.

Bible anchor "keep faith" and weapon "fight good fight" <u>2 Timothy 4:7, 1</u> Timothy 6:11-12

- Enough old nature make faith a struggle. Keeping faith lifelong task.
 - o Not live victorious Christian life if don't know Word.
 - Jesus fought good fight by Word three times in dessert.
 Matthew 4:1-11
- Word will change what you desire so obey freely and joyfully from within rather than coerced from without.
 - Read, memorize, and meditate on Word for internal transform that naturally produces outward fruit. <u>Colossians 1:10, Romans 12:1-2,</u> <u>John 15:5, Ephesians 6:16-18</u>

Not manufacture strength but strength from trusting in Jesus' infinite power.

- Holy Spirit and Word always work and fight together.
 - God faithful to equip and strengthen us to keep faith and fight good fight.
 - "When I try, I fail. When I trust, He succeeds." <u>2 Timothy</u> 2:3-7, 4:7-8

Under God, Scriptures greatest treasure in world.

- Bible is anchor for keeping the faith and a weapon for fighting good fight.
 - Continue in absolute allegiance to unchanging truth of God's Word.
- Be dedicated like soldier; disciplined like athlete; diligent like farmer in building LEFC, marriage, family, future on precious, powerful Word.
