Titus: "The" Truth 2024-02-25

<u> Titus 1:1-2</u>

Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness, 2 in hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began

In world filled with AI, relativism (no absolute truth, only relative, subjective), absolute truth comes from outside world and gives meaning to world.

• God is truth so He always speaks truth and always does what He says and promises.

Paul wrote Titus around 63-66 AD from Corinth between 1 and 2 Timothy.... One of three Pastoral Epistles

• Similar date, subjects, and purposes as 1 Timothy. <u>See outline at end.</u> We know very little of Titus.... was Greek and referred to 13 times in Paul's epistles.

- With Paul on third Missionary journey...pastor of Crete...large island off Greek coast notorious for treachery, violence, corruption, lying. <u>*Titus*</u> <u>1:12</u>
 - "Liars" from their claim tomb of Zeus on Crete.... a god, can't be dead.
- Verb "to cretize" was slang for lying or cheating. Missionary plan for Crete: preach Gospel and salvation, then develop sound doctrine result in hope for future and changed, purified lives. <u>*Titus 1:1-2,*</u> <u>*Hebrew 6:18, Jeremiah 10:10, Tozer*</u>
 - Sound doctrine for "lying" Cretans is that many may *have* truth but only Christian God Himself is absolute truth.

All Lord knows and thinks is true and correct understanding of reality.

• Because all Scripture God-breathed, must be totally true, completely honest, and thus final standard for truth. Job 37:16b, John 17:17, Proverbs 30:5a, 2 Timothy 3:16a, 2 Peter 1:20-21

Author of Scripture omniscient.... knows all true past, present, future facts.

- Truth and reality about God, creation, man, life, death, all things in Scripture.
 - Beliefs conform to Bible are true, not conform are not true.
 - The only "certain" truth is truth God revealed in Bible.

Jesus Himself is TRUTH because He was and is fully God, total embodiment of absolute truth in human flesh. *John 1:14, 18:37-38, 14:6 & 17*

- No danger of being deceived by believing what Jesus said.... He can't lie.
 - **Essence** of **true faith** is **taking God** at His **word** and **relying** on Him to **do** as He **promised**.

God is honest in every way so never renege on promises.

• Reason why hope of eternal life assured. <u>*Titus 1:2, 2:11-13, 3:7*</u>

• God's **truthfulness** and His **faithfulness.... interchangeable** terms.

When Christians embrace sound doctrine, result is hope for future and changed, purified lives that produce upright and holy living through regeneration and renewal by the Holy Spirit. <u>*Titus 3:3-8*</u>

- Gospel changes what people intrinsically are.... transform our nature.
 We used to be like Cretan's and without Jesus we'd still be like them.
- **Gospel** so **powerful** it **creates new** kind of **people** with a new **eternal future**.

• This how Gospel transforms Cretan culture and our society. God is Truth...not merely that God does not lie or can't lie.... thus, God is ultimate source of all truth. <u>Jeremiah 10:10</u>

- Truth finds its origin in God, its incarnation in Jesus Christ, it's expression in Gospel and its present manifestation in written Word of God, the Bible.
 - Hope of eternal life assured because God is truth, He always speaks truth, can't lie, always does what says and promises.
