Hebrews 11:6

without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

.... **Commend faith** of all in the room.... You sat down without even thinking. What if **one** chair was **weak**?

Faith automatic response of human spirit. We exercise it throughout day.

Problem: we place faith in wrong things, people, system, false gods
 Biblical faith rooted in who God is and who we are in Jesus.

Author, date (60-69 AD) of Hebrews mystery...only Holy Spirit authorship really matters.

• Hebrews connects the dots between the Old Testament and New Testament, it focuses on faith but more importantly, the object of our faith, Jesus Christ.

Hebrews considered 5th Gospel: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John are Jesus' earthly ministry, Hebrews is Jesus' heavenly, priestly ministry to Christian. <u>Hebrews 4:14-16</u>

- Hebrews written to Jewish Christians to keep from slipping back into rites and legalism of Judaism.
 - They think they lost things and heritage (priests, sacrifices) by accepting Gospel.
 - Persevere because they're not "giving up", but "receiving" better.
- Jesus **fulfills and supersedes** all great **Old Testament pillars and promises**. 1:1-2a, Lk 24:44 <u>See outline at the end*.</u>

Nicknamed The **Book of Faith**....**1 of 3** New Testament commentaries on Habakkuk 2:4. <u>See info at end**.</u>

- Hebrews tell us all about faith—what it is, where it's from, what it rests on, how to lay hold of it, how to live it out in everyday life. <u>Hebrews 11:1</u>
- Faith in itself is meaningless and powerless.

• **Power** of faith **derived from object or person** that we put our **faith in. Quantity** of **faith** is **not important** as **object** of **faith** is. Matthew 17:20

- Faith increases the more we know person and see a pattern that warrants trust.
 - Nothing mysterious about Biblical faith.... It is simple act of will.
 Either believe in God and His promises or don't.

Biblical faith is confident trust that God is who He says, and He can and will do what He promises He'll do. <u>Hebrews 1:1-4</u>

- Faith is means God determined for Christians to obtain all He makes available to us because of Jesus' atonement. <u>Hebrews 11:6, Rom 8:18</u>
 - Faith anticipates future, acts in present, evaluates past from God's perspective revealed in His Word. 2 Corinthians 4:17
- It's awareness of invisible realities not perceived by the five senses.

• Being certain of what you do not see! Believing is seeing. Hebrews is about faith but more importantly, the object of our faith: Jesus Christ.

- Hebrews **speaks** of Jesus **more** than any **other epistle**. <u>*Hebrews* 2:8, 17,</u> <u>7:22, 9:15</u>
- **Proclaims His character**, redemptive power, and **absolute supremacy**.
 - Hebrews exalts superiority of Jesus' person and work, prompting us to draw nearer to Him, thus increasing our faith and trust in Him!

Not great faith required as much as faith in a great God.

- Believe God exists and is exactly who His Word reveals Him to be.
 - If faith weak is nearly nonexistent—ask the Lord to increase your faith.

Faith is a gift from God: Jesus is the founder (beginning), perfecter (completer) of faith.

- God increases faith through daily relationship with Him and acting on little belief.
- Faith also increased when we hear testimonies of other's faith. <u>Hebrews</u> <u>12:1-2</u>

Chapter 11 full of ordinary people and did extraordinary things through the power of God by faith.

- Your faith is in the same God who wants to use you to do amazing things.
 - By faith put complete trust in Jesus' person and work, and He will generously reward you as you pursue your joy in Him. <u>Hebrews</u> <u>10:23-24</u>
