1 John: How to Be Sure 2024-04-14

<u>1 John 5:13</u>

I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life.

All Christians struggle with assurance... 1 John was written to reassure true believers.

• Assurance comes from believing Gospel truth, growing obedience, brotherly love.

Author: apostle John, also wrote Gospel book John. 1 John was written 85-95 AD and is among last New Testament books written. <u>See outline at the end.</u>

• Three themes repeat 3 times throughout 1 John: theological truth regarding Jesus, Christian obedience, love for brother.

Eternal life in Jesus Christ, who has **come in** the **flesh** <u>1 John 1:1-2, 2:21-22,</u> <u>4:1-3, 5:11-12</u>

• Gnostic theology: All matter is evil, spirit is good. Knowledge (gnosis) solves tension.

Two false theories that "improve" Christianity.... both distortions of Jesus' humanity.

- "Jesus" as a human was physical but the "Christ-spirit" came upon Him at His baptism, and left before death, so "Christ-spirit" never suffered.
- Jesus' ghost...hologram like Tupac at Coachella in 2012...Even though Tupac died in 1996.

One must believe GOSPEL TRUTH about Jesus Christ for assurance of salvation!

• These lies struck at heart of Gospel: Hypostatic union, incarnation, substitutionary death, and fellowship with Jesus possible.... fellowship with people, not holograms.

John, the only apostle still alive...knew Jesus well: Testifies Jesus was fully God and fully man, and that we can have intimate fellowship and relationship with the Lord. <u>1 John 1:3-4, 2:28</u>

- The word "fellowship" is used 9 times in the Bible...4 out of 9 times it's used in 1 John, which means very close friendship, or to do life together.
 - **"Abide**(s)" relates to fellowship. It's used 47 times in the Bible and used 23 times in 1 John.
 - Are your quiet times devotions or DEVOTION?

Fruit of abiding and fellowship with Jesus is transformed living.

• If Jesus is in you, you can't go on living in sin. <u>1 John 1:5-6, 2:3-4, 15b, 3:9</u> Gnosticism: complete abstinence (material things being evil) or unlimited indulgence (nothing can affect spiritual standing w/God) Essentially legalism or license.

• John is **clear**: there is **right and wrong**: Jesus Christ and anti-Jesus Christ's, **light and dark**, loving the **Father or loving the world**.

• Genuine faith produces God honoring obedience.

God has given us everything we need to obey Him.... Holy Spirit:

- WILL bear fruit of obey if you abide in Jesus Christ. 4:13, 5:13
 - Contradiction between profession and practice causes doubt of salvation.

It's difficult to consistently produce actions that verify faith in Jesus Christ.

• Heart's desire to obey but we have an advocate when we choose sin over God. <u>1</u> John 2:1-3

Saving faith believes and trusts Gospel truth, and that belief produces visible evidence of growing obedience and brotherly love. <u>1 John 2:11, 3:10, 16, 4:7, 5:1</u>

- Love of God for us is the prerequisite and foundation for loving others.
 - ALL love *agape*: love based on will, not emotions...aimed at those who are hard to love!
 - Anyone can love someone who is lovable.... It takes special effort to love those who hate you, mistreat, speak ill, or attack you....
 - That's the kind of love Jesus had for us. <u>1 John 4:10-12, 19-21, Romans 5:8, 10</u>
 - Heart and conscience testify if we really practice what we profess.... that we love one another and the LOST as God, in Jesus Christ, loved us.

Oneness with Jesus **enables lives** that are characterized by **truth**, obedience, and **love**.

- Assurance of eternal life comes from believing Gospel truth about Jesus (God and man, hypostatic union, incarnation, atonement) with visible evidence of growing obedience and brotherly love.
 - Truth meaningless if it doesn't change behavior.
