Delight in What the Lord Assigns to You 2024-05-12

1 Corinthians 7:17

Only let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him.

This is my rule in all the churches.

.... I am **not preaching on Revelations** today... for those who have read Revelations already, you get an extra week of reading. **This is out of the norm**... we are focusing on the **holiday: Mother's Day.**

- Any first-time moms? First-time grandmas? I'm jealous, because I long to be a grandpa.
 - Do not let your life longing become your idol and miss the present joy and the opportunity to glorify Jesus Christ.

The Lord created two equally important and valuable genders that reflect His character in very different ways.

- Biblical manhood and womanhood is the foundation of a healthy marriage, family, and society.
 - Today I am not focusing on gender differences or Biblical manhood or womanhood, but your God-ordained present life calling and situation.

God's **plan** for **some** is to **glorify Him** through the **gift** of **singleness** or **being married without children**. <u>1 Corinthians 7:8-9, Philippians 4:11-12, 1 Timothy</u> 6:6,

• It is idolatry if your joy and satisfaction is dependent on being married or having children, and not on Jesus Christ.

Delight in God's **present calling** in your life and **use your parental longing** to **bless** and mold someone else's **children** in **partnership with God** for **His glory**.

- We usually call those who act as parents "uncle" or "auntie" even though they are not related. Tom and Emily are great examples.
 - There are singles, married people without kids, empty nesters who serve Jesus, LEFC nursery, or Sunday School.

For parents with kids at home, the days can be long with young children, and frustrating with older children.

- When we struggle **remember** what **Scripture** says **regarding children**: they are a **blessing**, **reward**, and treasure. *Psalm* 127:3, 139:13-14, *Proverbs* 17:6a
 - If you feel like a failure, remember that you aren't going to parent perfectly, but you ARE the perfect parent for God's purposes for your child.
 - Knowing all your weaknesses, the Lord still ordained you as a parent for your children from the foundations of the world..... 2 Corinthians 3:5, 4:7

- Trust and hope in Jesus. He knows what He's doing! He is not done with you or your children.
 - In the busy, tired, chaos of parenting, it's easy to reminisce about life before kids and miss the joy and blessing of the present moment, and it's easy to long for an empty nest!

Empty nesters, be **careful that grandparenting** does **not** become an **idol** or **go** on **"cruise control"** and **withdraw** from **mentoring and serving** Jesus, and the young. *Titus 2:2-5, Job 12:12, Proverbs 20:29*

- Your calling as a life molder for Jesus is never over.....by God's grace your godly influence can spread throughout your family, LEFC, and the world.
- You hesitate to mentor because of your own failures as parents...that's the reason you won't find older people on parenting blogs.
 - Some of the best council comes from failure not victory!
- The young people of LEFC **need your wisdom**, prayer, example. <u>See Elliot/Body quotes at the end.</u>
 - o Be an encourager.... not a lecturer or a one-upper.
- Young people, the older people feel rejected when try give advice, so they stop until they are asked.
 - The problem in the world and church is that the same life cycle of people gets their primary counsel from each other.
 - It takes humility and persistence to seek council from godly older Christians, who are rich in spiritual and practical wisdom. 1 Peter 5:5.

Don't let your **life longing** become your **idol** and **miss** the present **joy** and the **opportunity** to **glorify** JC.

- We ALL must be willing to live a sacrificial life for Jesus Christ. 1 <u>Corinthians 7:17, Psalm 37:4</u>
 - EVERYONE....be a person of the Book, of the Word and of prayer.
 - The more you behold Jesus Christ, the more you will reflect Him!!!
- In every chapter of your life find your joy in Jesus and be devoted to the alory of God.
