Our Perfect Father 2024-06-16

Romans 8:14-16

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"

16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God

No Old Testament saint **addressed** God **as Father**, but in the **New Testament** at least **275 times**, Christians are **instructed** to **address** God **as Father**.

• **God** is **not** our **Father** through **creation** but through **adoption**. <u>Galatians</u> 4:4-7, John 1:12-13, Ephesians 1:5

Adoption through Jesus Christ's atonement is not earned by behavior, but through the gospel.

- All your sinfulness does not nullify your adoption. <u>Romans 8:35, 38-39</u>
 - Nothing can sever your sacred tie or separate the Christian from God's love.

Father title explains the type of intimate relationship He desires with his children. 2 Corinthians 6:18, Matthew 7:11

- This title **intended** to bring **comfort** and **joy** can be a **stumbling block**.
 - Studies show that we unconsciously attach feelings and impressions of our earthly dad to determine what we believe the Heavenly Father is like.

If you have suffered physical or emotional hurt, rejection, or even abandonment by earthly father or stepfather, you may struggle relating to God as your Father.

- You must forgive or bitterness will consume and hinder your fellowship with God. Ephesians 4:32
 - o Forgive as forgiven, you're not perfect either.
 - Scars remind you where you've been, but they don't have to dictate where you go.
- Believe who God really is: your perfect Father who ALWAYS was, is, and will be present through all the highs and lows of your life, even when nobody else was, or is. Your Father is omnipresent. <u>Psalm</u> 23:4a, <u>Hebrews 13:5</u>
 - It's not possible for Him to abandon you.
 - The issue is not the Heavenly Father's availability, but our awareness of the Father's presence.
 - Not only is He present but He is also there emotionally.

Not just present but supremely attentive and affectionate <u>Isaiah 49:15, Psalm 121:3</u>

- You always have his FULL attention; He is never too busy to listen when we pray and is never preoccupied with other problems. You can't "bother" Him!
 - Don't worry about taking His time. It's already yours.
 - He desires and longs to spend time with you.

Your Heavenly Father is always present, attentive and unconditionally, constantly loves YOU.

- He will never hurt or abandon or withdraw promises but will undeservedly bless YOU.
- When you sin, He will not reject you or hold you at arm's length.
 - If a child is muddy (sinning): reject the mud (sin) and not the child.
 - The Father will not reject but will pursue YOU with love and patience.
 - He always disciplines in love, not frustration or anger. <u>Hebrews</u> 12:7-11
 - Dads: ask God for grace and power to be like Him in this way.

His compassion, **understanding** and forgiveness is **measureless**, so whatever you **do** or **not do**, you will **never cease** to be a **child** in your **Heavenly Father's arms**. *Romans* 8:14-16, *Zephaniah* 3:17

- Stop striving for something you already have: the Father's love and favor.
- Stop wrestling, start nestling. Example: Jon's dedication.
 Fathers have the privilege of helping our children have a positive view of God.
 - All fathers are imperfect but strive through the Holy Spirit's empowerment to live in way that children see what the Heavenly Father really like.
 - o When you fail, humbly seek kid's forgiveness! Forgive yourself!
