## Faithful to His Bride 2024-08-11

## Acts 20:28

Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood.

**Last** week we talked about the **faithfulness** of **God** in **storms**, trials, and trouble. **Today**, we'll talk about how the Lord is **faithful** to His **church**.

 Central truth, and a Core Value at LEFC is that the church is led and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

The **root** meaning of "**church**" is **not** a **building** or organization, **but people**.

- The Greek translation, "ekklAsia" means "gathering, assembly, or a calling out".
  - o Biblically, the church is a community of all true believers for all time.
    - Called the church universal. <u>1 Corinthians 12:12-13</u>, Ephesians 4:4-6

Ultimately, we do not go to church; we are the church.

• **Here** is the **building**, here is the steeple, open the doors, the **church is** the **people**!

The **church** is **founded** by **Jesus**. He is its **Head** and **Savior**. <u>Matthew 16:18</u>, Colossians 1:18 Ephesians 5:23

- Jesus, the bridegroom, sacrificially and lovingly chose the church to be His bride
  - LEFC is not my church, or the elders church, but Jesus' church.
     His bride.

**Jesus Christ** is **righteously** and **completely jealous** for His **bride**. <u>John 17:20-</u>23, 1 John 4:11-12

- The overarching focus of the High Priestly Prayer is Jesus' love for His Church and importance of unity. Jesus talks about unity seven times in the High Priestly Prayer.
  - It is not unanimity or uniformity, but oneness of heart, faith and purpose through the transforming work of the Holy Spirit!

The church has **many reasons** for **disunity**: **social economic** status, personal **preference**, or **polity**.

- But the Gospel should transcend them all.
  - The enemy is not the lost, or your fellow Christians, but the devil. Ephesians 6:12, 1 Peter 5:8

**Unity** is **proof** that **Jesus** can **bring peace within** and **between** messed up people.

• If we are divided or "devouring", the lost can conclude our faith is not real or impotent.

 Are you a uniter or a divider of the body of Jesus Christ in life, in your words, or in social media?

There is no perfect church, but every church has an extraordinary, perfect Savior and Bridegroom that leads His imperfect bride lovingly and faithfully into His will for her. Romans 8:14

- Through a combination of the Word and indwelling, the Holy Spirit leads and empowers Christians and churches in specific ways that the Lord desires them to glorify His name.
- o Hearing God in order to serve Him is a Biblical pattern. God's Spirit lives in our spirit, it's no surprise that we can "sense in our spirit" (often in prayer) when God speak to us. <u>Acts 13:2-3, 1 Corinthians 2:11-12, Isaiah 30:21, John 10:27</u>
  - Today, the Lord will be sovereign, specifically in guiding and directing
    His bride at LEFC that He bought with a price through the vote of
    members in good standing.
    - Vote not on polity but simply if Ryan is His next LEFC Sr. Pastor
  - Pastors are overseers appointed by the Holy Spirit, NOT by men, to feed and care for the church that was purchased by Jesus' blood. <u>Acts</u> 20:28
- Jesus will decide, not us, just as He did 20 years ago!
   LEFC's Core Value: "The church is led and empowered by the Holy Spirit" is wonderfully God-centered and proclaims Jesus' faithfulness to His bride.
- Being "Word & Spirit" church should be core values of every church In next hour the Lord will reveal if Ryan is His choice for LEFC's Sr. Pastor.
  - There are two guarantees: 1. The Lord will decide. 2. Not the unanimity in vote.
    - The question is will ALL joyfully submit Lord's decision.
       Ephesians 4:1-3
