He's Speaking to You 2024-09-01

John 10:27

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

I will review the last 2 weeks for 2 reasons: to glorify God, and to correct inaccurate information, specifically for non-attenders.

- The result of the meeting on 8/11/24 with 69 members in attendance was 51 yes, 15 no, and 3 abstain. If you had counted abstains, Ryan would have been short .25%. If you hadn't counted abstains, Ryan would have had +1.5 more votes than he would have needed. What is the PROBABILITY of that happening?
 - The message on 8/11/24 had 2 guarantees: the first was that the Lord will decide. The second was that it will not be unanimous.
 - I said that the question is, will ALL joyfully submit Lord's decision?
 - With regards to the abstains, John Young and I misinformed the congregation, so the vote was "tainted". We contacted the district and received advice from Robert's Rules of Order coauthor.
- The **result** of the **vote** on **8/25/24** was that the **congregation decide** to revote with 56 yes and 7 no, with **64** members in attendance. Attendance was the same for the vote for Ryan. The **result** of the **vote** for Ryan was **48** yes and **16** no.
 - 9 people who voted "NO" also voted to revote. I'm proud of LEFC for having a heart for clarity.

The Lord **uniquely directs** and guides **His bride**: the **church** and **Christians**. <u>Acts</u> <u>8:29; Acts 13:2, Acts 9:11</u>

• The main point is to walk by the spirit and obey, you must hear and understand what the Holy Spirit says to you.

God **spoke throughout Bible:** whether it was audibly, through **angels**, through people, **dreams**, or **animals**.

- He spoke in the Gospels through Jesus Christ. To hear Jesus was to hear God. *John 1:1, 14*
- In every chapter of Acts, except 17, the Lord uniquely spoke to the people and to the church.
 - He still uses people, so we need the Holy Spirit's guidance as much as early church. My dream.
- Today we are led by the Holy Spirit primarily through the Word. <u>John</u> <u>16:13, 2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Corinthians 2:11</u>
 - Scripture is the surest voice of God.
 - Spiritual truth (Gospel) is revealed by the Holy Spirit, not discovered.

The cross purchased our adoption and opened Christians ears to the Father's voice. *John 10:27*

- Our living, loving, personal Father communicates with His children.
 - He encourages, convicts, corrects, counsels, comforts, and rejoices in us.
- The indwelling Holy Spirit takes biblical principles and truths, and specifically applies them to our individual lives so we can walk and live in a way that honors God.

The Holy Spirit **lives within**, so it's **no surprise** if we "have a sense" when **God speaks**, directs, or **guides** His people. <u>John 14:26, Acts 15:28, 1 Corinthians</u> 2:11-15

- The Holy Spirit **speaks through processes**, like LEFC's By-Laws, authority, and **other people**.
- O Whether it's friends, family, a sermon, a podcast, or a book. You should always filter subjective "voices, counsel, or prompts" through the objective Word, (in-line with Scripture) and wise, godly Christians, so you are not misled. 1 John 4:1, Jeremiah 17:9, Psalm 1:1, Philippians 4:7
 - God will never contradict His written word or be inconsistent with His character as revealed in Word and displayed in Jesus Christ.
 - The more we know God's Word, the more we can trust subjective promptings.
 - Be sure there are no hidden motives, whether directly or indirectly affected by decision
 - Good people can give bad counsel if it's "tainted" by the situation, or the people involved.
 - We can get additional confirmation through a God-given sense of peace.
 - Do not be led by your feelings, but lack of peace, or a check in your spirit may be God.
 - Discern between a "lack of peace" and something that is very difficult.

The Lord has a knowable will for you if you take time to listen: JC is & He not silent. <u>Jeremiah 33:3, Psalm 37:7a, 17:6, Isaiah 58:11a, 30:21, Galatians 5:25, 1 Kings 19:11-13, Mark 9:24</u>

- To walk by the spirit and obey you must hear and understand what the Holy Spirit says to you.
 - By faith ask God to give ears to hear Him. Stop, look, and listen.
 - STOP: silence voices that drown His "still, small" voice.
 - LOOK: at Word & motives/character
 - LISTEN: for God more, and you'll hear Him more! NYC story
