A Time of Transition 2024-10-06

Daniel 2:20-21

"Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, to whom belong wisdom and might.

He changes times and seasons; He removes kings and sets up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding;"

This message is based on my first LEFC message on Oct 10th, 2004.

- There are three things that are inevitable: death, taxes, and change. The Lord never changes but He is an agent of change. <u>Hebrews 13:8, Malachi 3:6, Daniel 2:20-21</u>
 - A leaf represents LEFC: we are in the midst of a God-ordained change and a transition to new and exciting season.
 - The definition of transition is the process of changing or passing from one state, form, subject or place to another.

The Bible records many **significant transitions**: Haran to Canaan, to Egypt, to Canaan.

 Maybe the most significant transition in Bible is from wilderness of discipline to the promised land, and the transition of God-ordained leadership of Moses to Joshua. <u>Joshua 1:1-2</u>

Israel **lived** in the **wilderness** by God's **miraculous provision**.

- In promised land of Canaan, Israel had to walk and live by faith.

 This transition foreshadows and presents a picture of Jesus Christ atoning work. The Old Covenant law is fulfilled, and the New Covenant is instituted.
 - Moses represented the law, Joshua represented God's provision of salvation in Jesus Christ.
 - Joshua was originally called Hoshea, which means salvation.
 Numbers 13:16, Matthew 5:17, 1 Corinthians 11:25
 - Moses changed to his name to Joshua, which means "the Lord saves, Lord gives victory".
 - The Greek form of Joshua is <u>JESUS</u>

Many things passed away with **Moses**: the Glory **cloud**, the Pillar of fire, the provision of **Manna**.

- It's difficult to let go of the past and step out onto new ground.
 - We like the past. It's comfortable, and we know what to expect.
 "Moses did it this way."

We should **learn** from the **past**. **Don't live in** it or **idolize** it!!! <u>Deuteronomy 34:5-</u>7, *Philippians 3:13b-14*

- We still don't know exactly where Moses' grave is.
 - Maybe because people would worship him at his gravesite. That's not what Moses would have wanted.

- Remember and honor the past, but live in the present, and look forward to the future.
 - The end of 1 chapter allows the beginning of another glorious chapter of the Lord working in and through His people. This is true now for LEFC and for me.

The **Lord brings** His ppl **through** the **Jordan** with Joshua **like He** took **their fathers** through the **Red Sea** with **Moses**.

- The greatest Christian leaders are only servants. They are just a glove on the Lord's hand. *Matthew 23:11-12*
 - The Lord does not need anyone or anything to accomplish anything in world or our lives but chooses to use people for His glory.

Moses' task was completed so God chose Joshua to continue His work.

- Moses was 80 when he led the people out of Egypt. Joshua was around
 70 to 80 when they crossed the Jordan.
 - o "Classic" Christians, do NOT put YOURSELF "out to pasture"!
 - The Lord never promised it would be easy serving Him. <u>2</u>
 <u>Timothy 2:2-4</u>
- God's passion is for you, not the work you do in His name. Mark 12:33
 Every God-ordained leader needs hidden heroes: people who are not up front but serve behind scenes, many times doing hard, uncomfortable things.
 Exodus 17:8-13
 - Moses had Joshua and many hidden heroes.
 - Ryan is the God-ordained Senior Pastor for LEFC next season.
 - LEFC leadership needs hidden heroes to glorify God!
 - We need to support Ryan and the Elders with prayer, and Holy-Spirit led service.
